



ESBES Travel award for Early Career Researchers Procedure

ESBES Board approved sponsoring conference registration fees at ESBES and ECAB conferences for early career researchers to enable them to attend these conferences and engage with the biochemical engineering community.

Eligibility

- Early Career Researcher currently registered as PhD student or within 5 years of completion of their PhD.
- Member of one ESBES member society.
- It is advisable for the applicants to join the relevant ESBES Section.

Requirements

The award is non transferrable and must be used for the conference stated on the form.

Awardees unable to take up the award for this purpose relinquish the award in full.

The applicants must be eligible to present their research of relevance to ESBES at the stated conference.

The awardees will register at to the conference and present one communication (poster or oral). Awardees presenting oral communications will be given preference.

Within a month of the conference, the awardees will send to the ESBES office a short report (500 words) on the conference and its impact on their research and career. This report will be published on the ESBES website and disseminated through the ESBES newsletter and other dissemination channels. Wherever appropriate, the awardees will widely disseminate the conference through social media to maximise the impact.

Process

- 1) Call for applications is issued annually via ESBES office and publicised on the relevant conference website.
- 2) Applicants shall fill in the attached forms and send it to the ESBES office via e-mail (office@esbesweb.org) together with:
 - a. Proof of membership of ESBES member organization
 - b. Copy of the submitted abstract and proof of acceptance.
 - c. Copy of Receipt for traveling expenses.
- 3) A nominated ESBES sponsorship committee will review and rank the applications
- 4) All applicants will be informed of the outcome of the review of their application.
- 5) Amount, deadlines and detailed procedure are specified together with the award call for applications.
- 6) Awardees will submit a report on conference to the ESBES office within a month of the conference taking place.
